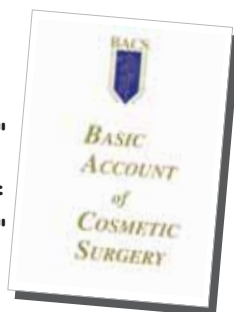

Guide to Ear Reshape



Guide to Ear Reshape

Technical Name

Otoplasty

Aims

The purpose of otoplasty is to reduce the distance between the side of the head and the protruding part of the ear to about 15mm ($\frac{1}{2}$ ").

Indications

The ears are considered to be abnormally protruding if the distance between the side of the head and the most protruding part of the ear is more than 20mm ($\frac{3}{4}$ "). This condition is inherited.

Preoperative Considerations

By the age of six or seven the ear has usually reached adult size but surgical correction can be performed as early as the fifth year of life.

The Operation

Anaesthetic: General (young children)
Local (older children & adults)

Duration of Operation: 1 hour

1. Incisions are made in the groove behind the ear so that scars are hidden from view.
2. The skin is lifted from the underlying cartilage.
3. The cartilage is suitably reshaped and trimmed accordingly and the skin edges are stitched using dissolvable stitches.
4. A turban bandage is usually applied for twenty-four hours and removed before discharge home.

Duration of Stay in Clinic: 1 night

Time Required Off Work/School: 1 week

Postoperative Management

A bandage is worn at night time until healing is complete.

Results

Otoplasty is one of the most frequent and successful operations in cosmetic surgery. The result is permanent and ears that were a source of great embarrassment should look normal.
