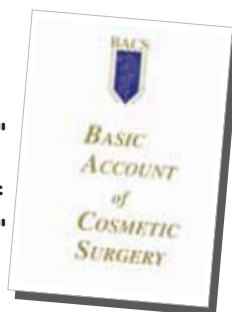

Guide to Nose Reshape



Guide to Nose Reshape

Technical Name

Rhinoplasty

Aims

The purpose of rhinoplasty is to repair injuries which have caused a noticeable deformity and to improve a nose that has become an unacceptable shape during growth and development.

Indications

The best candidates are those patients who don't like their noses and who may be very self-conscious of being seen in profile, but who will accept an improvement even if the new nose isn't perfect.

Preoperative Considerations

Some of the limiting factors in rhinoplasty are:

- Contour and shape of the face
- Texture and thickness of the skin
- Inclination of the chin, lip and forehead
- Depth of the angle between the forehead and the nose
- The height of the patient
- Healing powers of the tissues

The Operation

Anaesthetic: General

Duration of Operation: 1 hour

1. Essentially, the external contour of the nose is modified by altering the internal bony and cartilaginous framework through an approach from the inside of the nose, thereby leaving no external scars.
2. At the completion of the operation a splint is placed on the nose and secured in position with sticky tape. The purpose of the splint is to immobilise the fractured nasal bones and reconstructed cartilaginous framework in order to allow optimum healing conditions.
3. Soft packs are placed inside each nostril for twenty-four hours.

Duration of Stay in Clinic: 1 night

Time Required Off Work: 10 days

Postoperative Management

The patient goes home having had the packs removed, but wearing the splint which is removed after a week to ten days. Until the splint is removed, patients are advised to rest as much as possible, sleep upright, sneeze through the mouth and avoid blowing the nose.

Results

The amount of scar tissue formed under the skin after the operation will have a major influence on the final shape but most patients are delighted with the result of their rhinoplasty operation.
